

An Ordinance, Amending Sec. 1 of Ordinance 1.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Nucla.  
That Section 1 of Ordinance 1 be amended to read as follows:

Concerning animals running at large. Sec.1 - That any cattle, swine, mules, horses, jacks, asses, goats, or stallions running at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Nucla, State of Colorado, are hereby declared to be a nuisance and any owner or keeper of any such animal who shall permit or suffer the same to run or be at large within said town, shall be subject to a minimum fine of two dollars (\$2.00) for each such animal suffered to remain at large.
