AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 229 SECTION 4.1, BY INCREASING THE RATE FOR ANIMAL LICENSE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF NUCLA, COLORADO.

SECTION 4.1 DOG AND CAT LICENSE FEE: The annual rates for animal license shall be \$5.00 for spayed and neutered dogs and cats and \$10.00 for all other cats and dogs commencing January 23, 2012. Fees collected above and beyond the cost of providing a rabies clinic each year, the town cost to maintain licensing for dogs and cats and any fees pertaining to court dealing with animals, will be given to Hoof and Paw as long as they provide the service of fostering strays, abandoned, lost or gone astray cats and dogs removing them from the streets in the Town of Nucla.


All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Passed this 14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011.


