ORDINANCE NO. 2014-0003

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2013-06 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING OWNERSHIP OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF NUCLA, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. Rabies Control 2.2 RABIES TAG: The owner of an animal requiring a rabies vaccination shall provide a certificate of vaccination that is serially numbered and bearing the year of the issuance and the name of the jurisdiction and state in lieu of a metal rabies tag. A metal rabies tag attached to the collar of the pet will be at the discretion of the owner.


Section 4. Dog and Cat Licenses 4.2 LICENSE DISPLAYED: The town license tag shall be attached to a collar, harness or other device by the licensed dog or cat at all times, and shall not be removed from any dog or cat by an unauthorized person. The original dog or cat license receipt and rabies vaccination certificate shall be retained by the owner or harboror for inspection by any person charged with the enforcement of this Ordinance.

All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


The effective date of this ordinance as provided by the Board of Trustees shall be immediate.


