

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 41, BEING ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING REVENUE AND RELATING TO THE SALE OF MALT, VINOUS AND SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS AND IMPOSING AN OCCUPATION TAX UPON THOSE ENGAGED IN SUCH SALE AT RETAIL AND TO SECURE A PROPER DISTRIBUTION OF THE BURDEN OF TAXATION".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF NUCLIA, STATE OF COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 4 of said Ordinance No. 41 be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. There is hereby levied and assessed for the year 1954 and for each year thereafter an annual occupation tax upon the business of selling 3.2% beer, malt, vinous or spirituous liquors, except medicinal liquors, in the Town of Nucla, as said occupation has been herein classified as follows:

For all Class "A" Operators	the sum of Four Hundred (400) Dollars
For all Class "B" Operators	the sum of Four Hundred (400) Dollars
For all Class "C" Operators	the sum of Two Hundred (200) Dollars
For all Class "D" Operators	the sum of Two Hundred (200) Dollars
For all Class "E" Operators	the sum of One Hundred Fifty (150) Dollars
For all Class "F-1" Operators	the sum of One Hundred (100) Dollars
For all Class "F-2" Operators	the sum of One Hundred (100) Dollars

Section 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
