

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LABOR FOR PRISONERS
COMMITTED TO IMPRISONMENT FOR THE VIOLATION
OF ANY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NUCLA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
NUCLA, COLORADO:

Section 1. Every person committed to the County jail, town prison, workhouse, house of correction or other place provided by the Town of Nucla for the violation of any ordinance of said town may be required to work for the said town at such labor as his strength will permit, within or without such prison, workhouse, house of correction or other place provided for the incarceration of such offenders.

Section 2. Said person shall not work exceeding ten (10) hours each working day and for such work the person so employed to be allowed, exclusive of board, not less than two dollars (\$2.00) per day for each days work, said amounts to be credited on account of such fine and costs.

Section 3. Each and every ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 4. It is hereby declared that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall be in effect and in force five (5) days after its passage and publication.
