

ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED TAXPAYING ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF NUCLIA, COLORADO AT A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 3, 1956 THE QUESTION OF CONTRACTING AN INDEBTEDNESS ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF NUCLIA AND UPON THE CREDIT THEREOF BY ISSUING NEGOTIABLE BONDS OF SAID TOWN IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF ~~\$10,000.00~~ ^{\$10,000.00} FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMODELING AND ENLARGING THE TOWN HALL.

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the town of Nuclia, Colorado deem it advisable to remodel and enlarge the town hall of said town; and

WHEREAS the town of Nuclia does not have in its treasury sufficient money available for such purposes; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees deem it necessary and desirable to issue bonds of the town for such purposes subject to the approving vote of the qualified taxpaying electors of the town;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF NUCLIA, COLORADO:

Section 1. That at a general municipal election to be held in the town of Nuclia, Colorado on the 3rd day of April, 1956 there shall be and there is hereby submitted to a vote of the qualified taxpaying electors of said town the following question:

"Shall the Board of ~~Trustees~~ ^{Trustees} of the town of Nuclia, Colorado contract an indebtedness on behalf of the town and on the credit thereof, by issuing the negotiable bonds of the town in the aggregate amount of ~~\$10,000.00~~ ^{\$10,000.00} for the purpose of remodeling and enlarging the town hall of said town?"

Section 2. Only qualified registered taxpaying electors of the town shall be permitted to vote upon the question submitted.

Section 3. The question so submitted shall be voted on at said election by qualified electors, at the polling place designated in the notice of election hereinafter set forth. The vote shall be taken



as nearly as may be in the manner prescribed by law for elections of municipal officers.

Section 4. The ballots to be used in voting upon the question submitted shall be prepared and furnished by the Town Clerk to the judges of election, to be by them furnished to the voters, and they shall be in substantially the following form:

INSTRUCTION TO VOTERS: The voter shall prepare his ballot, indicating his approval or disapproval of the foregoing proposition by placing a cross (X) opposite the group of words above which expresses his choice on said question, and shall then deposit his ballot in the ballot box provided for such purpose.

Section 5. The following judges and clerks are hereby

appointed to conduct the election on the bond question hereinbefore set forth:

Receiving Judges: *Hertinde V. Sly, Anna E. Stielt, & Elva Clark*

Receiving Clerks: *Dorothy Hearn & Gerald Stephens*

Counting Judges: *Hertinde V. Sly, Anna E. Stielt & Elva Clark*

Counting Clerks: *Dorothy Hearn & Gerald Stephens*

Section 6. The votes cast at said election on the question

aforesaid shall be returned and canvassed and the results declared in

Registration for said election will take place in the manner now provided by law. Any person possessing qualifications to vote at said election but whose name does not appear on the official registration list, may register with the Town Clerk of Nucla, Colorado at any time during business hours up to and including Tuesday, the 27th day of March, 1956, one week before said election.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of Trustees of the town of Nucla, Colorado has caused this notice to be published and posted as required by law, and dated this 13th day of March, 1956.
