

ORDINANCE NO. 59ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF
REAL ESTATE

WHEREAS, at the general municipal election of the town of Nucla, Colorado held on April 3, 1956, the qualified tax paying electors authorized the Mayor of said town to convey the property described in Section 3 hereof to the County of Montrose, and

WHEREAS, the County of Montrose by its Board of County Commissioners is agreeable to accepting title to said property for the sole purpose of erecting a building to be used as a jail, both by the County of Montrose and the Town of Nucla.

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Nucla:

1. That the town of Nucla, by good and sufficient deed, convey to the County of Montrose, Colorado that property described in Section 3 hereof in order that said County may construct a building to be used as a jail, both by the County of Montrose and the Town of Nucla thereon.
2. That the mayor execute said deed and his signature be attested by the Town Clerk and the corporate seal of said town be affixed thereof.

3. That the legal description of said property is as follows:

Lot 6, Block 61, as the amended plat of the Town of Nucla, Colorado on record at the County Court House at Montrose, Colorado
