ORDINANCE NO. 62

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL

FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING

JANUARY 1, 1957

SECTION I:

That for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Town of Nucla, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1957, there is hereby appropriated from the moneys now in the Treasury of the Town and from the revenue collected by said Town during the fiscal year ensuing, and not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$43,143.46

SECTION II:

That the said amount is hereby appropriated for the following specific objects and purposes:
