

ORDINANCE NO. 34

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
FOR THE TOWN OF NUCLA, COLORADO
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1964
AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1964

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
NUCLA, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of defraying all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Town of Nucla, Colorado for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1964 and terminating December 31, 1964, there is hereby levied a tax of 19.00 mills of the assessed valuation of all taxable property, real, personal, and mixed within the limits of the Town of Nucla, Colorado which is subject to taxation for State and County purposes.

Section 2. That all monies collected from such taxation and levy, when paid to the Town Clerk of said Town, be by said Town Clerk duly apportioned and credited to the funds as fixed and determined by resolutions, ordinances, or statutes.

Section 3. That it be, and hereby is, made the duty of the Town Clerk to certify the tax levy herein provided for to the County Clerk and to the Board of County Commissioners of Montrose County, Colorado, promptly after the final passage and publication of this ordinance, for extension and collection as provided by law.

Section 4. That for the purpose of providing for the payment of maintenance and operation of the water works system, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$16,870.02 from all the revenue of the Town, including the revenues of the Water Department; that an appropriation is also made for the retirement of water bonds and interest as follows: Bonds and interest, Town of Nucla Water Bonds 1947, 1952, 1954, 1956 and 1962 - \$17,417.50.

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Section 5. For the purpose of providing a general fund for the payment of all expenses of the Town of Nucla not otherwise provided for herein, and, in accordance with the items contained in the budget heretofore adopted, there is appropriated to said fund in the sum of \$21,835.98 out of the mill levy and any un-expected balance remaining in said general fund after the payment of bills for the calendar year ending December 31, 1963, and together with all monies collected from fees, licenses, special taxes, and all other revenues not otherwise appropriated, including water department revenues, all of which monies shall be placed in the general fund.
