ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL DIVISION'S REQUEST FOR  
REVOCATION OF MR. RONALD L. WEISSHAAR'S WATER TREATMENT  
CERTIFICATE

---

THE COLORADO WATER AND WASTEWATER FACILITY OPERATORS  
CERTIFICATION BOARD, having read and considered the Water Quality Control  
Division's Motion for Entry of Default and Default Judgment, HEREBY ORDERS:

1. Venue and jurisdiction have been considered and are proper.
2. Judgment in the above matter is granted to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Water Quality Control Division.
3. This Board's regulations requires that, in the conduct of his duties, an operator in responsible charge must exercise reasonable care and judgement, understand the applicable requirements of the Colorado Primary Drinking Water Regulations, report situations to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Water Quality Control Division that could result in non-compliance, and refrain from submitting misleading documents to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Water Quality Control Division. *See* Operator Certification Requirements, 5 CCR 1002-2, Regs. 100.16, 100.20.1, 100.20.2. Failure to comply with these requirements constitutes grounds for revocation under section 100.20 of this Board's regulations. *See* Operator Certification Requirements, Reg. 100.20. Mr. Weisshaar failed to comply with these requirements.

ACCORDINGLY, THIS BOARD ORDERS the revocation of the water treatment and water distribution certifications held by Mr. Ronald L. Weisshaar, certified operator number **6834**.

ACCORDINGLY, THIS BOARD REPRIMANDS Mr. Weisshaar with regard to his wastewater treatment and collection system certifications.
