

ORDINANCE No. 314

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE BALL PARK

WHEREAS, Dogs urinating and defecating on the infield, outfield and track surfaces of the ball park will cause damage to the grass and health and safety conditions to persons using the ball park, and

WHEREAS, For the protection of the investment involved in installing sod at the ball park and for keeping the grass at the ball park from damage by dogs defecating and urinating, and for the health and safety of persons using the ball park, the Town Board of the City of Creede has determined dogs shall not be allowed on the ball field at any time.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the City of Creede:

SECTION 1.

1. That it shall be unlawful for any dog to enter the playing surface of the ball field, whether said dog is leashed or not leashed.

SECTION 2. Any owner of or person responsible for any dog violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$300.

SECTION 3. Owners of or persons responsible for dogs are directed to take their dog(s) to the area west of the railroad right-of-way for walking their dogs.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.


SECTION 5. The Board finds and declares that this Ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and shall take effect and be enforced upon adoption.


SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be codified into the Municipal Code. Any changes in numbering of paragraphs, sections or subparagraphs shall not change the validity of any part of the Ordinance. The word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Title", "Section", "Subsection", or "Code" as necessary.
