

ORDINANCE NO. 321

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Creede has authority to vacate streets and alleys within the municipal limits, under CRS 31-15-7092, and;

WHEREAS, The Town Board has determined that certain streets are no longer needed for traffic within the Town and should be vacated.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the City of Creede

SECTION 1. That the alley running NNW by SSE through the east side of Lots 22, 23, 24, 25 and the west side of Lots 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 all in Block 24, ending at Wall Street, in Creedmoor, City of Creede, Mineral County is hereby vacated, reserving to the City of Creede an easement along the flume in its present location and extending 15 feet on the outsides of the bank of the flume.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3. NECESSITY. It is hereby declared that this Ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and shall take effect and be enforced from and after its final adoption.

SECTION 4. CODIFICATION. This Ordinance shall be codified into the Municipal Code. Any changes in numbering of paragraphs, sections, or subparagraphs shall not change the validity of any part of the Ordinance. The word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Title", "Section," "Subsection", or "Code" as necessary.
