

**CITY OF CREEDE
ORDINANCE NO. 340**

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE DISTANCE FROM SCHOOL FACILITIES FOR LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to CRS §31-15-103, a municipality has the authority to make ordinances; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to CRS §12-47-313(1)(II), as the local liquor licensing authority, Creede has the ability to modify the required distance from a school at which a liquor license can be granted; and

WHEREAS, the City of Creede has determined, that following a public hearing, the distance from a school that a liquor license may be granted, as set forth in CRS §12-47-313(1)(d)(I) should be modified;

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Creede to modify said distance.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, a Town in Mineral County, Colorado:

Section 1. Pursuant to CRS §12-47-313(1)(III) the City of Creede sets the lawful distance from a school facility, as defined in the Colorado Statutes, that a liquor license may be applied for and issued, at Two Hundred and Sixty Feet (260 feet).

Section 2. Creede City Ordinance No. 182 (Municipal Code Section 10-8-60), is hereby modified to change the distance from 500 feet to 260 feet for the activities prohibited by that Ordinance.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, a Town, hereby declare that it is in the best interests of the City of Creede, Colorado and of its residents that this change in liquor licensing distance be enacted.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective 30 days after publication in the local newspaper.
