



## ORDINANCE NO. 351

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO, ESTABLISHING THE POSITION AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to CRS §31-15-103, municipalities have the authority to enact, publish and enforce ordinances, codes and regulations, and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Creede has determined that it in the best interests of the citizens of Creede to establish a position to enforce the town's ordinances, codes and regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, THAT:**

- Section 1:** The position of Code Enforcement Officer is established for the City of Creede, a Colorado Town.
- Section 2:** The City of Creede's Code Enforcement Officers are hereby given the authority to enforce the City's Municipal Code, Land Use Code, Building Code and associated regulations. The Code Enforcement Officer has the authority to issue complaints and summonses, pursuant to C.M.C.R. 206, or to initiate nuisance abatement proceedings and take other lawful actions to abate violations of the City's ordinances, codes and regulations.
- Section 3:** This ordinance amends and supercedes any city municipal code requirement that ordinance violations be cited by a law enforcement agent.
