

ORDINANCE 11-A

AN ORDINANCE RAISING RATES FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF WATER TO RESIDENTS AND NON RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO AMENDING SECTION 7(a) AND (b) OF ORDINANCE NO. 4-A OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, KIT CARSON COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 7(a) and (b) of Ordinance No. 4-A of the Town of Stratton, Colorado is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) Rates to the resident consumers shall be as follows: The first 3,000 gallons per month shall be at a rate of \$6.00; All water consumed over 3,000 gallons shall be at a rate of \$.30 per 1,000 gallons.
- (b) Rates to non-resident consumers shall be as follows: The first 3,000 gallons per month shall be at the rate of \$9.00 ; All water consumed over 3,000 gallons per month shall be at the rate of \$.45 per 1,000 gallons.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees finds and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, affects the public peace, health and safety, and, therefore an emergency exists, and that this ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the publication thereof.
