

ORDINANCE NO. 31A

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE 29A (AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CUTTING AND REMOVAL OF WEEDS, BRUSH AND RUBBISH FROM LOTS IN THE TOWN OF STRATTON, AND PROVIDING FOR THE DOING OF SUCH WORK BY THE TOWN IN CASE OF THE FAILURE OF THE OWNER TO PERFORM, AND FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE CHARGES THEREFORE AGAINST LOTS AND FOR THE COLLECTION OF SUCH ASSESSMENTS AS TAXES, AND FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON:

Section 1. Section 2 H. "Growing Season" of said Ordinance No. 29A is hereby repealed. Section 2 I. "Real Property" is hereby designated as Section 2 H. and Section 2 J. "Town Board" is hereby designated as Section 2 I. of said Ordinance No. 29A.

Section 2. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 29A which presently reads in its entirety as follows:

Section 4. The owner of real property located within the established and legal boundaries of the Town shall control weed growth on their real property by mowing at least once during the growing season any such weeds to a height of not more than two (2) inches above ground level. -

is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 4. All owners of real property located within the established and legal boundaries of the Town shall control weed and/or grass growth on their real property by mowing any such and/or grass to a height of not more than six (6) inches and maintaining all weed and/or grass growth at a height of not more than six (6) inches at all times.

The Board of Trustees finds and declares that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and, therefore, an emergency exists and that this Ordinance shall become effective five days after publication thereof.
