

ORDINANCE NO. 33B

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING INCREASE IN WATER CHARGES FOR THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town finds that in order to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town, regulations relating to water services are necessary;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town finds that water services are reasonably related in that they help to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to increase water rates which were adopted on July 10, 2008. The increase in water rates is deemed necessary by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton, Colorado in order to pay for necessary improvements and maintenance of the water system, and to obtain grant funds from all available sources.

Section 2. Amendment to Ordinance Nos. 93A, 10B, 15B and 17B. The Town of Stratton has previously adopted Ordinance No. 94A. Ordinance No. 94A was amended by Ordinance No. 10B and both ordinances were subsequently amended by Ordinance No. 15B. Finally, these three ordinances were amended by Ordinance No. 17B. These four ordinances shall remain in full force and effect, except that the residential and commercial water rates shall be changed and are hereby adopted as follows:

RESIDENT:

Residential Water – One Unit - \$21.15 per month
Commercial Water – One Unit - \$34.15 per month

NON-RESIDENT:


Residential Water – One Unit - \$34.15 per month
Commercial Water – One Unit - \$46.65 per month

Section 3. Inconsistent Ordinances. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect, it being the intent that this Ordinance shall stand, notwithstanding the invalidated or unconstitutionality of any part thereof.

Section 5. Immediate Effect. It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, welfare and safety of the residents of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, and shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as provided for by law.
