

ORDINANCE NO. 76A

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF "SEVENTH STREET" IN STEGMAN'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF CLAREMONT (NOW STRATTON, COLORADO) TO "CLAREMONT STREET".

Whereas, the plat of "Stegman's Addition to the Town of Claremont" was recorded in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder of Kit Carson County, State of Colorado, in Book 1, at Page 58, on or about July 11, 1908, identifying and naming a portion of said plat as "Seventh Street"; and

Whereas, a plat named "Resurvey of Stegman's Addition to the Town of Claremont (now Stratton)" was recorded in Book 583, at Page 201, and filed in Plat Book 3, at Page 3, in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder of Kit Carson County, State of Colorado, on February 16, 1983, identifying and naming a portion of said plat as "Seventh Street"; and

Whereas, it is desirable to preserve the heritage of the Town of Stratton and make visible to the public the recognition of the former name of the Town of Stratton by changing the name of "Seventh Street" to "Claremont Street".

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. "Seventh Street" as identified as such in that certain plat of "Stegman's Addition to the Town of Claremont" recorded in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder of Kit Carson County, State of Colorado, in Book 1, at Page 58, on or about July 11, 1908, and identified as such in that certain plat named "Resurvey of Stegman's Addition to the Town of Claremont (now Stratton)" recorded in Book 583, at Page 201, and filed in Plat Book 3, at Page 3, in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder of Kit Carson County, State of Colorado, on February 16, 1983, is hereby changed to "Claremont Street" and shall hereafter be referred to as "Claremont Street".

SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees finds and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and, therefore, an emergency exists, and this ordinance, shall be recorded in the Book of Ordinances of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and attested by the Town Clerk under the corporate seal of the Town and shall be published in the "Stratton Spotlight", a public weekly newspaper published within the corporate limits of the Town of Stratton and the County of Kit Carson and State of Colorado and shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.




