

ORDINANCE NO. 97A

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AMENDED PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES DATED JULY, 2000

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF STRATTON, COLORADO:

Section 1. Ordinance adopted pursuant to statutory power. Pursuant to 31-15-201(b), C.R.S., the Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton has the power to provide by Ordinance rules and procedures concerning all town officers and all town employees, and to provide for the appointment, term of office, removal, powers, duties and compensation of such officers and employees.

Section 2. Adoption of personnel policies and procedures. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton hereby adopts and approves the Personnel Policies and Procedures handbook dated July, 2000, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All conflicting ordinances, including any previous personal policies and procedures, are hereby repealed and replaced as stated herein.

Section 4. Severance Clause. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause, phrase, or language of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid, the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, phrases or language of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, it being the legislative intent that this ordinance shall stand notwithstanding any invalidity or unconstitutionality of any part of the ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. The Board of Trustees finds and declares that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and, therefore, an emergency exists, and this Ordinance shall be recorded in the Book of Ordinances of the Town of Stratton, Colorado, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and attested by the Clerk under the corporate seal of the Town and shall be published in "The Stratton Spotlight", a public weekly newspaper published within the corporate limits of the Town of Stratton and the County of Kit Carson and State of Colorado, and shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.


