



## Please read the following before submitting your complaint

We investigate all complaints submitted, however we typically do not reply to your submission unless further information is needed.

You can choose to remain anonymous; however, providing your contact information will give us a way to obtain additional information to complete a more thorough investigation. Your complaint will be entered verbatim into the complaint investigation document, therefore we cannot exclude any information that you provide us and your anonymity may not be kept based on facts that you provide.

**PACFA does not regulate the following: animal neglect/cruelty, noise disturbances, dogs at large, property line issues and impound matters. If you witnessed conditions that you believe represent an imminent danger to any animals, please call your local law enforcement agency immediately so that they can address the situation promptly.**

If you have concerns about Livestock (Horses, Llamas, Cattle, Goats etc...) please call the Animal Health Department at 303-869-9130. If you have concerns about a Veterinarian please contact the State Board of Veterinary Medicine at 303-894-7800.

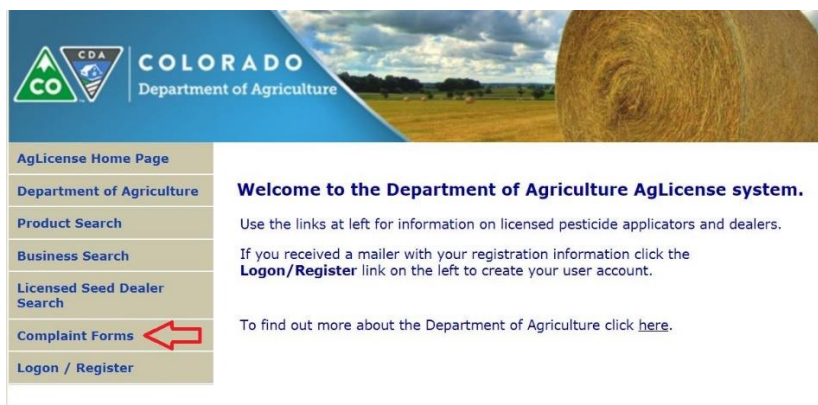
### Do you have additional documents?
