



PART-TIME HOURLY REQUIREMENTS

Every participant is required to engage in the clinical practice of the profession for which he/she applied and was awarded, at his/her CHSC-approved site(s). Part-time clinical practice is defined, for the purposes of the CHSC, as a minimum of **20** hours per week, for a minimum of 45 weeks each service year.

MOST HEALTH PROFESSIONALS except OBGYN and mental health providers

At least **16** of the minimum 20 hours per week must be spent providing direct patient care (face-to-face) in the outpatient ambulatory care setting(s) at the approved site(s), during normally scheduled office hours. The remaining **4** hours of the minimum 20 hours per week must be spent providing clinical services for patients or teaching in the approved site(s), providing clinical services in alternative settings (e.g., hospitals, nursing homes, shelters) as directed by the approved site(s), or performing practice-related administrative activities. Practice-related administrative activities shall not exceed 4 hours.

OB/GYN and FAMILY PHYSICIANS WHO PRACTICE OBSTETRICS OR GERIATRICS, CERTIFIED NURSE MIDWIVES and PEDIATRIC DENTISTS

At least **11** of the minimum 20 hours per week must be spent providing direct patient care (face-to-face) in the outpatient ambulatory care setting(s) at the approved site(s), during normally scheduled office hours. The remaining **9** hours of the minimum 20 hours per week must be spent providing clinical services for patients or teaching in the approved site(s), providing clinical services in alternative settings (e.g., hospitals, nursing homes, shelters) as directed by the approved site(s), or performing practice-related administrative activities. Practice-related administrative activities shall not exceed 4 hours.

MENTAL AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROVIDERS

At least **11** of the minimum 20 hours per week must be spent providing direct face-to-face patient care (patient counseling) in the outpatient ambulatory care setting(s) at the approved site(s), during normally scheduled office hours. The remaining **9** hours of the minimum 20 hours per week must be spent providing *clinical services* for patients or teaching in the approved site(s), providing clinical services in alternative settings (e.g., hospitals, nursing homes, shelters) as directed by the approved site(s), or performing practice-related administrative activities. *Note:* up to **5** hours can be in an alternate setting and practice-related administrative activities shall not exceed **4** hours of the minimum 20 hours per week.
