- Fair market value issues - PO needed for formula, diapers, etc.
- Charting - adding patient education



- Data is collected by Lactation each day on rounds to determine exclusivity, pacifier usage, etc.

Data Collection and Documentation


- Data is then entered in to an excel spreadsheet
- Once completely entered it is reviewed by lactation for missing items and corrected
- Spreadsheet is then sent to someone in quality who puts it in to graph format
