SUBJECT: 2014 School Data
TO: Sponsors of family day care homes and at-risk afterschool programs

Annually, the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) posts current year school data on the CDE website based on each school's prior October Free and Reduced-price meal household qualifications. The data for School Year 2014 is now available for sponsoring organizations to access when determining area eligibility for family day care homes and at-risk afterschool programs. The SY 2014 data is effective from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015, beginning with the January 2015 claim for reimbursement. The data is available at the following link:

On the above webpage, access the school data by selecting the "PK-12 Free and Reduced Lunch Eligibility by District and School" link with the Excel abbreviation (XLSX).

The CDPHE-CACFP reminds sponsoring organizations to review the CDPHE-CACFP Procedure Memorandums, FDCH #15-02 and CENTERS #15-02, for additional guidance when using school data to determine area eligibility. Community Eligibility Provision data may be required for area eligibility determinations for some school areas.

Sponsors of family day care homes are required to obtain income data from family day care home providers whose five year eligibility expires (beginning in February of the current year) and who are losing school area eligibility. Providers who lose eligibility in January 2015 must be reclassified by area or income by January 31, 2015 to continue receiving Tier I reimbursement. The CDPHE-CACFP will soon release a revised Family Day Care Homes Sponsor's Manual, which consolidates information from previous years' guidance memorandums about the use of school data for Tier I eligibility determination.
