The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment-Child and Adult Care Food Program (CDPHE-CACFP) received the following United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) policies, which are attached with this memorandum:

- SP 02-2016, CACFP 02-2016, SFSP 02-2016, *Questions and Answers on the Transition to, and Implementation of 2 CFR Part 200*
- SP 04-2016, CACFP 04-2016, SFSP 04-2016, *Local Agency Procurement Reviews, School Year 2015-2016*
- SP 12-2016, CACFP 05-2016, SFSP 09-2016, *Guidance on Competitive Procurement Standards for Program Operators*
