Data represent children age 20 years and under who had at least one day of eligibility during the fiscal year. Counts of clients are distinct within county or program. However, totals may not represent unique clients. Example: if a client moves to another county within the time frame, they will be counted twice. All clients who are enrolled in Medicaid are eligible for Early and Periodic Screening Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT). Therefore, the breakdown of children 20 years of age or under eligible for Medicaid is identical to the breakdown of these same clients on EPSDT.

Eligibility types that are included and are what eligibility figures represent include 001-011. Counts of clients are distinct within county or program. However, totals may not represent unique clients. Example: if a client moves to another county within the time frame, they will be counted twice. All clients who are enrolled in Medicaid are eligible for EPSDT. Therefore, the breakdown of children 20 years of age or under eligible for Medicaid is identical to the breakdown of these same clients on EPSDT.
