


Colorado Maternal & Child Health Priority on Early Childhood Obesity Prevention (Child Care Setting)

Nationally, child care settings are recognized as a tremendous opportunity to prevent obesity. Infrastructure exists in Colorado and can be leveraged to support this focus. The overall strategy is to use the capacity of state and local early childhood systems and partners to deliver the interventions to child care providers.
