PHARMACY I C8E1XX	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in pharmacy and possession of a Colorado Pharmacist License. Positions with working assignments as pharmacy inspectors require three years of practice as a licensed pharmacist and/or pharmaceutical inspector.	
PHARMACY II C8E2XX	Positions with work assignments as a pharmacist require graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in pharmacy and two years of experience as a licensed pharmacist. Positions with working assignments as pharmacy inspectors require four years of practice as a licensed pharmacist and/or pharmaceutical inspector.	
PHARMACY III C8E3XX	Positions with work assignments as a pharmacist require graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in pharmacy and three years of experience as a licensed pharmacist.
