Applicants must successfully pass a polygraph, background investigation and a drug test. Applicants will be disqualified for the use of any illegal drugs in the past three years, conviction of a felony crime or conviction of a domestic violence charge. All CSP members are subject to random drug testing.

Pay

The Colorado State Patrol offers competitive compensation. Attendance at an 8 week training academy is required. After one year of successful performance, officers may be eligible for a promotion that also includes a pay increase.

Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age
- Must be a Colorado Resident and possess a valid State of Colorado Driver's License
- High school Diploma/GED preferred
- Be willing to work nights, weekends and holidays
- Be able to communicate fluently in English and have a clear speaking voice

Job Description

POE Officer Interns are the first level in the POE Officer classification, and are law enforcement officers.

POE Officers work includes safety, size and weight regulation. The duties of a POE Officer contribute to highway safety and saving lives.

Officers visually and physically inspect the condition of commercial motor vehicles and drivers to detect unsafe conditions, and verify compliance with laws, rules and regulations.

The inspection process includes: reviewing permits, registrations, licenses, shipping papers and vehicle loads; weighing loads to determine gross and axle weights; measuring the height, length and width of the vehicle and/or load; and checking for non-taxed fuel.

Officers issue citations or summonses to drivers. Once certified as a safety inspector, officers conduct safety inspections and are authorized to declare a driver and or vehicle out of service for violations.
