




10:25-10:50	<p>Administrative updates: Title X legislative and funding updates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Title X decreased their grant commitment to CDPHE by 1 year. Instead of the original 3-year grant (2016-2019), they scaled back by one year which means our grant expired June 30, 2018. CDPHE continues to track Title X and will report to family planning contractors immediately when updates based on fact arise. State funds (\$4.1 million total) are secure until June 30, 2018 and we are optimistic the state will continue to fund the program. <p>Date Updates: Birth Rates continue to decrease:</p>	Jody



The rapid increase in LARC adoption in Colorado Title X clinics that occurred during the initiative did not appear to be associated with increased Chlamydia rates.

Chlamydia rates were lower for Title X LARC users than for nonusers between 2003 and 2016.

After the Colorado Family Planning Initiative became established, Chlamydia rates among Title X Family Planning female clients fell among LARC users and nonusers. Young women under age 25 drove the decline.
