



Colorado Healthy Hospital Compact Partner Hospital Agreement

This agreement is between _____
(Partner Hospital) and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE)
regarding participation in the Colorado Healthy Hospital Compact (the Compact).

The Colorado Healthy Hospital Compact (the Compact) is a statewide movement facilitated by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to create healthier food and beverage environments in hospitals. Hospitals enter the Compact as Partner Hospitals. As Partner Hospitals make health promoting changes to nutrition environments, they will be formally recognized by CDPHE at the Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Platinum level.

Purpose

This agreement sets forth the commitments to be undertaken by Partner Hospital and CDPHE as Compact members and collaborators.

CDPHE will provide technical assistance to Partner Hospitals that undertake to accomplish Program standards. Formal recognition will be awarded to Partner Hospitals that satisfactorily accomplish Program standards. CDPHE will foster and support a peer network of Partner Hospitals to connect those hospitals to best practices and innovations in the national healthy hospital movement.

Duration

By signing this document, the parties agree to collaborate on the Colorado Healthy Hospital Compact, to uphold the activities and standards outlined above, and to preserve and promote the health of the people of Colorado to make the State of Colorado a healthier place to live.

This agreement will remain in effect until modified or terminated by THE SIGNING PARTNER OR by mutual consent between the Partner Hospital and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.

This agreement is not a binding contract enforceable in a court of law or in an administrative forum. It is intended only to establish a process and framework for further cooperation between CDPHE and the Partner Hospital.



To participate in the Colorado Healthy Hospital Compact, the Partner Hospital commits to the following:

- 1. Identify a point person to guide healthy hospital work and serve as a liaison to the Compact.
