



What You Need to Know About Documenting Historical Immunizations in CIIS

Providers often encounter patients who don't have adequate documentation of historical immunizations.

With the exception of influenza vaccine and pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PPSV23), providers should only accept written, dated records as evidence of immunization. Self-reported doses of influenza vaccine and PPSV23 are acceptable.

Although immunizations for a patient shouldn't be postponed if records can't be found, an attempt to locate missing records should be made by:

- reviewing CIIS;
- contacting the patient's previous health care provider(s); and
- asking the patient to search for patient-held records (e.g., tri-fold, yellow record, etc.).

If records can't be located within a reasonable timeframe, the patient should be considered susceptible and started on the age-appropriate immunization schedule. Serologic testing for immunity is an alternative to immunization for certain antigens.

Adding Historical Immunizations in CIIS

Update

Step 3. Use the drop-down arrow to select the clinic to be associated with the historical immunization. By default this is set to the *Patient Record - PR*.

- The *Show* field will default to *All Vaccines* when the patient is over 18 years of age. If the patient is younger than 18, this field will default to *Child Vaccines*.
- *Date of Varicella* field: If the History of Varicella field is set to yes, you can specify a date for the disease in this field. This date is used as the effective date when creating the associated contraindication. Once a date is set, the field becomes read-only and can only be modified via the Precautions/Contraindications.

Step 4. Enter the date the past (historical) vaccination was administered as indicated on the patient’s record. Next, select the check box for each immunization that was administered on the date you indicated at the top of the column.

Step 5. Once you have entered all of the historical immunization data, click on the *Add* button to save the information to the patient’s record.

Please note: There are two versions of this screen. Each user can specify their preferred version of the screen on the *User Defaults* screen located under the *Settings* module.

Check this box if you would like to set the patient's default clinic to your current default clinic.

Step 4. Enter the date the past (historical) vaccination was administered as indicated on the patient's record. Next, select the check box for each immunization that was administered on the date you indicated at the top of the column.
