

PY12 Local Plan Approvals

The Colorado Workforce Development Council gave the Executive Committee the authority to approve the Program Year 2012 Local Plans from the regions. For the first time, CWDC has combined the Local Plan, Continuous Improvement Management System (CIMS) Plan, and Local WIB Recertification into one plan. This reduces redundancy and allows the regions to submit their progress reports on a consistent schedule. The Program Year 2012 Local Plans were first reviewed by the Program and Fiscal Monitors at the Colorado Department of Labor & Employment. Their recommendations were provided to a task group of Council members, who then provided their comments. CWDC staff also reviewed the plans. The task group's recommendations were given to the Executive Committee for approval, which can be found below. Regions have received a letter notifying them of their Approved status and providing conditions (if necessary) and feedback.
