



GOING PACIFIC

We are excited to begin our migration from FatWire to Drupal; the new content management system for the Colorado.gov websites. Within Drupal, we have built a platform that is specific to our partner's website needs. This is the Pacific platform.



The Pacific platform offers two permission levels to Partners: Minisite Administrator (MSA) and Content Managers (CM). There are two additional permissions available in the system, but they are reserved solely for Colorado Interactive staff to perform platform administrative duties. Below is a description of the MSA and CM permissions:

MINISITE ADMINISTRATOR (MSA)

- Highest permission level available to entity
- Has access to all entity websites (for entities with more than one website)
- Creates and manages system users (CMs)
- Has ability to change the site structure (homepage layout, navigation, color schemes, etc)
- Handles content administration
- MSAs must be provisioned by Colorado Interactive staff
- No limit on number of MSAs you can provision, however, Colorado Interactive recommends having no more than three given the level of access this role provides

CONTENT MANAGER (CM)

- Content creation
- Content editing
- Content publishing
- CMs must be provisioned by Minisite Administrator/s
- No limit on number of CMs you can provision
