

This is an announcement to all current users of the Pacific CMS Platform.

The latest release of The Pacific Platform has been deployed and tested successfully. All of the functionality outlined in the patch notes below has been implemented in the Production Environment.

Patch Notes

Here are the patch notes that reflect the changes included in this release:

- PAC-200 - Organic Group Site Node Aliases Can Be Overwritten
 - This fix ensures that the system will properly reserve URL aliases created by Pacific Sites.

 - PAC-149 - Implement a File Management Solution (Closed Beta)
 - A new system for managing files on the Pacific Platform has been released for internal testing. This functionality will be released for platform-wide use once internal testing criteria has been satisfied.

 - PAC-237 - Allow Menus to render in visible page area regardless of window size
 - Top-down selected menu items will now render within the visible area of a browser whenever possible.

 - PAC-245 - Implement Brand Colorado Footer Logo Content Type and View
 - A new content type has been implemented for Mini-site Admin users. An optional logo graphic can now be added to the footer area of any site.

 - PAC-233 - Module Updates - Pacific Sprint 13
 - Multiple modules have been updated to the latest version.

 - PAC-234 - Accessibility - Links and Footer Links open in new tab after release 1.12.1
 - Footer links open in the same window as of this release.

 - PAC-99 - Allow banner images to be configurable, click-able links
 - All Pacific Site Banners can now have a link assigned to them, making them a click-able object. This field is blank by default, so existing banners will not experience any change until they are updated by a Minisite Admin.

 - PAC-249 - Implement a better way to add content links via the WYSIWYG
 - A new button has been added to the WYSIWYG editor that allows users to insert adaptive links to any existing content.
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
