
It protects against pneumococcal disease. *Pneumococcus* is a bacteria that can cause:

- Pneumonia (infection in the lungs)
- Bacteremia (infection in the blood)
- Meningitis (infection in the coverings of the brain and spinal column)

These infections are serious and can be deadly. Most at risk are infants and toddlers, adults over age 65, and people with certain medical conditions.

Kaiser and UHC members are eligible for the Pneumonia Vaccine at **NO COST!**

For those not covered under a state medical plan, the cost will be \$92.



WHO SHOULD GET THE VACCINE?

All adults 65 years of age and older.

Anyone 2 through 64 years of age who has a long-term health problem or condition that lowers the body's resistance to infection such as:

*Heart Disease - Lung Disease - Sickle Cell - Diabetes - Alcoholism - Cirrhosis
Hodgkin's Disease - Lymphoma or Leukemia - Kidney Failure - Multiple Myeloma
Nephrotic Syndrome - HIV infection or AIDS - Damaged Spleen - Organ Transplant
Smokers - Those who have Asthma - Those taking certain Cancer Medications*
