## Notice of Proposed Bylaws Change

The Planning Committee is proposing the following change to the Commission's bylaws.

It has been observed that Section V (g) of the bylaws, Meeting Attendance, allows the members of the Commission who represent the Executive Branch to designate a delegate to attend Commission meetings in their place. This provision does not provide the same opportunity for the "Representative of the All-Payer Health Claims Database." Yet, as a nonvoting member, it is felt that this individual should have the same opportunity as the other nonvoting members.

The Committee therefore recommends the following amendment to the bylaws:

### Meeting Attendance

"Except for the *nonvoting members of the Commission*, no commission member, nor Committee member, may send a delegate to represent them at any meeting."

Pursuant to the requirements in the bylaws, this proposed change will be acted upon in the January meeting of the Commission (January 12, 2015).
