

Provider Billing Workshop Class Descriptions

Beginning Billing Class Description

Beginning Billing classes are for new billers, billers who would like a refresher, and billers who would like to network with other billers about the Colorado Medical Assistance Program. Currently the class covers in-depth information on resources, eligibility, timely filing, reconciling remittance statements, and completion of the UB-04 and the Colorado 1500 paper claim forms.

The Beginning Billing classes do not cover any specialty billing information.

Provider Enrollment Application Workshop

This workshop focuses on the importance of correctly completing the Colorado Medical Assistance Program Provider Enrollment Application. Newly enrolling providers, persons with the responsibility for enrolling providers within their groups, association representatives, and anyone who wants to better understand the Colorado Medical Assistance Program enrollment requirements should attend.

Audiology

This class is for those billing for audiology services using the Colorado 1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for Audiologists.

Dental

This class is for those billing for dental services using the 2006 ADA/837D claim format. The class covers billing procedures, claim formats, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for the following provider types: Dentists, Dental Hygienists

Durable Medical Equipment (DME)/Supply

This class is for those billing for DME and supplies using the Colorado 1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues, and guidelines specifically for Supply/DME providers.

Federally Qualified Health Centers and Rural Health Centers (FQHC/RHC)

This class is for those billing for FQHC/RHC services using the UB-04/837I and Colorado 1500/837P format. The class covers billing procedures, Encounter Payments, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for FQHC/RHC providers.

Dialysis

This class is for those billing for dialysis services using the UB-04/837I and/or Colorado 1500/837P claim formats. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for dialysis providers. *(This is not the class for Hospitals – please refer to the Hospital Class)*

Home Health

This class is for those billing for Home Health services using the UB-04/837I claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues, and guidelines specifically for Home Health providers.

Hospice

This class is for those billing for Hospice services using the UB-04/837I format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for Hospice providers.

Inpatient/Outpatient (IP/OP) Hospital

This class is for those billing for in-patient and out-patient hospital services using the UB-04/837I claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for In-patient Hospital and Out-patient Hospital providers.

Nurse Home Visitor Program (NHVP)

This class is for those billing for Nurse Home Visitor services on the CO1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for Nurse Home Visitor providers.

Nursing Facility

This class is for those billing for Nursing Facility services using the UB-04/837I claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues, PETI, Medicare Crossovers, and guidelines specifically for Nursing Facility providers.

Occupational, Physical, and Speech Therapy (OT, PT and ST)

This class is for those billing for Occupational, Physical, and Speech Therapy services using the Colorado 1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for Occupational, Physical, and Speech Therapy providers.

Outpatient (OP) Substance Abuse

This class is for those billing for outpatient substance abuse treatment (substance abuse assessment, individual and family therapy, group therapy, alcohol/drug screening, case management and social/ambulatory detoxification services) using the Colorado 1500/837P claim format: The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for outpatient substance abuse providers.

Pharmacy

This class is for those billing for prescription drugs using the Pharmacy claim format/Point of Sale and/or PCF Format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for Pharmacies. *(This is not the class for DME/ Supply Providers – please refer to DME/Supply Provider Class.)*

Practitioner

This class is for those billing for billing for practitioner services using the Colorado 1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for the following provider types:

Transportation

This class is for those billing for emergency transportation services billing on the Colorado 1500/837P and/or UB-04/837I claim formats. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues, and guidelines specifically for Transportation providers.

Vision

This class is for those billing for vision services by ophthalmologists, optometrists, and opticians billing on the Colorado 1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues, and guidelines specifically for practitioners providing vision services.

Waiver Programs – Beginning Billing

Home and Community Based Services- Brain Injury (HCBS-BI)

This class is for those billing for HCBS-BI services (adult day care, non-medical transportation, home electronics, home modifications and personal care) using the Colorado 1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for HCBS-BI providers.

Home and Community Based Services- Elderly Blind and Disabled (HCBS-EBD), Persons Living with Aids (PLWA), and Community Mental Health Supports (CMHS)

This class is for those billing for HCBS-EBD, HCBS-PLWA and HCBS-CMHS services :(adult day care, non-medical transportation, home electronics, home modifications and personal care) using the Colorado 1500/837P claim format. The class covers billing procedures, common billing issues and guidelines specifically for the following provider types:
