

## **Sponsorship Services for Clients Experiencing Critical Events related to HIV Risk and Living with HIV Application 2443**

### **Questions and Answers**

**Question:** On Page 10 of the RFA, Section E. #6 – both A and B list other requirements. This was a bit confusing and we wondered if they are both referring to the same thing.

**Answer:** On page 10 Section E – 6 should be as follows:

- a. Summary of Experience: no more than four (4) pages
- b. Other Requirements, Scope of Work Table, and Evaluation: no more than eight (8) pages

A revised RFA has been posted.

**Question:** On the Work Plan, we wondered about the date for Objective #1. It says Target date is June of 2016 and we wondered if this should be June 2017.

**Answer:** On the Work Plan, the date for Objective #1 is due 30 days after the start of the contract. A revised Attachment F has been posted.

**Question:** On the Work Plan, Objective #4, the dates for 4-1 through 4-3 have already passed (3/31/16). Could you clarify if this should be 2017?

**Answer:** On the Work Plan, Objective #4 the dates for 4-1, 4-2 and 4-3 should be through 3/31/ 2017. A revised Attachment F has been posted.

**Question:** In section A.5.b., there are two sections that are listed as b. (Personnel and Adherence to Standards). We are assuming that Adherence to Standards should be c. and Evaluation should be d. but wanted to clarify.

**Answer:** Yes that is correct, on page 8 Adherence to Standards should be c. and Evaluation should be d. A revised RFA has been posted.
