DESIGN CONCEPT SITE STATISTICS

<p>Most contiguous park space ~2.4 acres</p> <p>Buffer space shown between Miner St. and Colorado Blvd.: 0.4 acres</p>
<p>Parking (92 spaces)</p> <p>Visitors Center parking lot is expanded to show 26 spaces</p> <p>On-street parking for the park is shown with a combination of parallel and angled parking: 66 spaces</p>
<p>Rafting parking is shown as relocated to the north side of the creek</p>

<p>Road pavement area represented along Colorado (highlighted in white), intersection of Miner and Colorado, one way and exit route of Miner and Visitors Center parking</p> <p>Approximately 1.6 acres</p>
<p>Miner St. becomes one way, east of the Visitors Center</p> <p>New road alignment will slow traffic</p> <p>Creates a gateway</p> <p>Pedestrian and bike friendly</p>
