RESOLUTION NO. 1971- 5

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA CONCERNING THE EXTENSION OF THE SEWER LINE FROM THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA TO CENTAURI HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, The Town of La Jara is a duly incorporated town in the State of Colorado pursuant to an incorporation of the same, as such remains on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Colorado;

AND WHEREAS, The Town of La Jara has recently caused to be constructed an improvement to the sewer system of the Town of La Jara, consisting of an outfall line and sewer treatment facilities;

AND WHEREAS, The Town of La Jara is desirous of making available to the residents of the Town of La Jara and the surrounding area full and adequate sewage collection and treatment services in order that the general health and welfare of the community may be fostered, promoted and improved;

AND WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of North Conejos School District RE-1J have requested that a sewer line be extended to Centauri High School, as such is located approximately one and one-eighth (1-1/8) miles South of the Town of La Jara along U.S. Highway 285, and such sewer trunk line would be of benefit not only to Centauri High School and the students therein, but also to adjacent property owners who desire to utilize such service;

AND WHEREAS, such sewer service line would likewise serve the Conejos County Hospital, as owned by the Conejos County Hospital District, and sewer services are badly needed for both of such facilities together with the need to serve the general inhabitants of the immediate area through which such line passes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara, that proper application be made in order to obtain funds for the construction of the facilities for a sewer trunk line from the South boundary of the Town of La Jara to the

Centauri High School in order that the same may be obtained and constructed and E. Gale Martin, as Mayor of the Town of La Jara, be and is hereby designated as agent to execute such applications as may be necessary in order to effect the foregoing, make application for grant funds from the United States of America and to execute any and all applications and documents in consideration thereof, and to generally do all things necessary to effect and obtain the foregoing improvements.
