RESOLUTION NO. 1980- 1

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara is authorized by law to charge reasonable rates for water and/or sewer services, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara is empowered by Ordinance No. 1979-5 adopted and approved the 20th day of June, 1979, to make changes in rates for water and/or sewer services by a resolution duly adopted and approved by the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary to revise or amend the rates to be charged for connection with and use of the Town's sewage and/or water system in order to raise sufficient funds, after the payment and maintenance and operating expenses, with which to make the installment payment of principal and interest on bonded indebtedness of the Town as the same becomes due,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara, Conejos County, Colorado, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment to Section 1.19. That Section 1.19 of Ordinance No. 1970-4, --TAP FEE FOR CONNECTIONS AFTER JANUARY 1, 1971--as amended, be repealed and re-enacted as follows:

"Section 1.19. TAP FEES FOR CONNECTIONS AFTER March 31, 1980. The tap fees to be paid to the Town of La Jara for connections to the said Town Waterworks System for all connections after March 31, 1980, whether made to a dwelling unit or other building situate within the incorporated limits of the Town of La Jara shall be the sum of \$500. Tap fees to be paid to the Town of La Jara for connections to said Town Waterworks hereafter made to any dwelling unit or other building situate outside the incorporated limits of the Town of La Jara shall be the sum of \$875 and shall be based upon the availability of services and facilities.

No tap connection, either within or without the incorporated limits of the Town of La Jara, shall hereafter be made with such waterworks system until the required tap fee shall have been paid to the Town Clerk and a permit to make such connection issued by the Town Clerk.

Section 2. All water and/or sewer users of the Town of La Jara, Colorado, shall be notified in writing of changes in rate as by this Resolution made as soon as is reasonably possible after the adoption of this Resolution.
