

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-1

A RESOLUTION TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY OF
ADMINISTERING ACCESS PERMITS AS PROVIDED BY
THE COLORADO STATE HIGHWAY ACCESS CODE AS
ADOPTED BY THE COLORADO STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, on August 31, 1981, the State Highway Access Code, adopted by the State Highway Commission, went into effect; and

WHEREAS, according to Paragraph (5) (a), the administration of access permits to state highways automatically becomes the administrative responsibility of the Town of La Jara on the effective date of the Access Code; and


WHEREAS, the Town of La Jara, by and through its Board of Trustees, finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the Town and its citizens to assume the responsibility of administering the access permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THIS BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO, HEREBY:

1. Assume the responsibility of administering the access permits as hereinabove set forth;
2. Cooperate with the Colorado State Highway Commission, other state and local agencies with respect to the administration of said access permits;
3. That upon the filing of an application for an access permit, the matter be referred to the La Jara Planning Commission, the La Jara Zoning Commission, and such other commission of the Town as shall then be appropriate for its consideration, review, and recommendation prior to any final action with respect to the same by the La Jara Board of Trustees;
4. Appoints the La Jara Town Clerk as the appropriate town official to obtain and maintain such forms as shall be necessary for the administration of the foregoing;
5. Agrees to take other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the foregoing Resolution.


