

RESOLUTION 1990-5  
BUDGETARY TRANSFERS  
SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGETS AND APPROPRIATIONS

A Resolution appropriating additional sums of money to defray expenses in excess of amounts budgeted for the Town of La Jara, Colorado.


Whereas, the receipt of unanticipated revenue or revenues not assured at the time of the adoption of the budget from any source other than the local government's property tax mill levy--use of fund balance, money in reserve, namely:

- 1) The amount of \$25,000 budgeted for street paving in General Fund was increased to \$100,000 to come out of reserve money (CD's in bank).
- 2) The amount of \$4,000 budgeted out of Police Pension Fund was transferred to General Fund.

Now, Therefore, be it resolved by the Town Board of the Town of La Jara, Colorado:

Section 1. That the 1990 appropriation for the General Fund is hereby increased from \$228,290 to \$332,290 for the following purpose:  
Street Paving, Police Pension Payment.
