

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-1

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND, AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE 1ST DAY OF JANUARY, 2001 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER, 2001

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA HAS APPOINTED A BUDGET COMMITTEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A PROPOSED BUDGET TO SAID GOVERNING BODY AT THE PROPER TIME, AND;

WHEREAS, THE BUDGET COMMITTEE HAS SUBMITTED A PROPOSED BUDGET TO THIS GOVERNING BODY ON THE 12TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2000, FOR ITS CONSIDERATION, AND;

WHEREAS, UPON DUE AND PROPER NOTICE, PUBLISHED OR POSTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW, SAID PROPOSED BUDGET WAS OPEN FOR INSPECTION BY THE PUBLIC AT A DESIGNATED PLACE, A PUBLIC HEARING WAS HELD ON THE 14TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2000, AND INTERESTED TAXPAYERS WERE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO FILE OR REGISTER ANY OBJECTIONS TO SAID PROPOSED BUDGET, AND,

WHEREAS, WHATEVER INCREASES MAY HAVE BEEN MADE IN EXPENDITURES, LIKE INCREASES WERE ADDED TO THE REVENUES SO THAT THE BUDGET REMAINS IN BALANCE, AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA COLORADO:

SECTION 1. THAT ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES FOR EACH FUND ARE AS FOLLOWS.

SECTION 2. THAT ESTIMATED REVENUES FOR EACH FUND ARE AS FOLLOWS:




