

RESOLUTION 2000-6

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2000, TO HELP DEFRAID THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO FOR THE 2001 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO HAD ADOPTED THE ANNUAL BUDGET IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET LAW, ON DECEMBER 14, 2000 AND;

WHEREAS, THE AMOUNT OF MONEY NECESSARY TO BALANCE THE BUDGET FOR GENERAL OPERATION EXPENSES IS \$ 47,687 AND;

WHEREAS, THE 2000 VALUATION FOR ASSESSMENT FOR THE TOWN OF LA JARA AS CERTIFIED BY THE COUNTY ASSESSOR IS \$2,670,939.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. THAT FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEETING ALL GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE TOWN OF LA JARA DURING THE 2001 BUDGET YEAR, THERE IS HEREBY LEVIED A TAX OF 17.854 MILLS UPON EACH DOLLAR OF THE TOTAL VALUATION FOR ASSESSMENT OF ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN FOR THE YEAR 2001.

SECTION 2. THAT THE "CERTIFICATION OF TAX LEVY: TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CONEJOS COUNTY, COLORADO, SUBMITTED BY THE MAYOR ON DECEMBER 15, 2000 IS HEREBY RATIFIED.
