RESOLUTION NO. 2006 - / _____

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE RE-NAMING OF ELEMENTARY STREET IN THE EASTERN PART OF TOWN TO MAIN STREET SOUTH AS LYING WITHIN THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA

WHEREAS, there is on file in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder of Conejos County, Colorado a Plat of the County Road Annexation to the Town of La Jara as more particularly filed for record on the 27th day of January, 1987, in Book 7 of Plats at Page 167, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the annexation was to bring within the incorporated limits of the town a county road lying at the easternmost limits of the town running north to south to the southern boundary of the town incorporated limits, and

WHEREAS, said county road had theretofore been referred to as ELEMENTARY STREET in that portions of said county road fronted the elementary school of the North Conejos School District RE-1J, said reference being done in an informal manner rather than the formal adoption of the a resolution by the Board of Trustees designating said county road as such in light of the fact that the Board of Trustees did not have jurisdiction over said road, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Conejos County, Colorado, to join as signatories to an Annexation Plat by which said county road would be annexed to the Town in return for which the Town would assume henceforth all expenses of repair and maintenance of said road, and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of setting forth the legal description of said county road to be annexed to the Town, a survey plat thereof was prepared and ultimately filed for record in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder of Conejos County as set forth above, and

WHEREAS, the county road theretofore being referred to as ELEMENTARY STREET was set forth on said plat as **MAIN STREET SOUTH**, and

WHEREAS, as part of the annexation, there was filed in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder of Conejos County, Colorado, on January 27, 1987, under Reception No. 192384 in Book 331 at Pages 317-18 Ordinance No. 1987-1 entitled, "An Ordinance Annexing Territory to the Town of La Jara, by which said county road was annexed into the Town of La Jara, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the Board of clear up confusion that may exist now or in the future as to the legal name of the street after its annexation into the Town of La Jara and the correct physical addresses of the various residence located on the west side of the said street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That, henceforth, the street having as its point of beginning the easternmost terminus of Main Street as set forth on the above referenced Plat, thence running southeasterly and around a curve to ultimately run south to the point of intersection of said street with Colorado Highway 139, shall be known as **MAIN STREET SOUTH**, and such name shall henceforth be its official, legal name.

2. That the La Jara Town Clerk, be, and she is hereby, authorized to cause a copy of this Resolution, bearing the Town's official seal, to be recorded in the real estate records of the Clerk and Recorder of Conejos County, in order to give notice to the public of the Town's official action.

3. That, to the extent practical and necessary, copies of this Resolution be provided to law enforcement personnel, utility companies, and such other persons and/or entities in need of such information.


