

RESOLUTION 2008-1

A RESOLUTION CANCELING THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 1, 2008 AND DECLARING CERTAIN CANDIDATES ELECTED

WHEREAS, there is now tentatively scheduled a municipal election to be held by the Town of La Jara on April 1, 2008 for the purpose of electing three persons to the office of member of the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara to fill vacancies with respect thereto arising from the expiration of the term of three present office holders,

AND WHEREAS, only three candidates, namely ROMAN MAESTAS, PATRICK MONTOYA and PAULA MEDINA, have filed nomination petitions, all of such documents having been filed in the form and manner and within the periods of time required by law and by the Town of La Jara Ordinance 1982.-1,

AND WHEREAS, said Ordinance 1982-1, adopted by the Town of La Jara pursuant to Colo. Rev. Stat. § 31-10-507, provides that, if the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office and if, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such an election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent, the Clerk shall certify such fact to the governing body, and it shall hold a meeting and may cancel the election and by resolution declare the candidates elected,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Board of Trustees finds that the only matter before the voters with respect to the municipal election tentatively scheduled April 1, 2008, is the election of persons to office and that there were not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent.
2. That the Board of Trustees finds that there are now three vacancies on the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara arising from termination of the term of office of three persons presently holding such offices.
3. That the Board of Trustees finds that there are now only three candidates, namely ROMAN MAESTAS, PATRICK MONTOYA and PAULA MEDINA, such being the number equal to the offices to be filled at such election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

1. That, pursuant to the terms and provisions of said Ordinance No. 1982-1, the above-named three candidates, namely ROMAN MAESTAS, PATRICK MONTOYA and PAULA MEDINA be, and they are hereby declared to be, duly qualified to assume the duties of the office of members of the Board of Trustees in the Town of La Jara and are hereby deemed to be duly elected for a four-year term.
2. That notice of such cancellation shall be published, if possible, in order to inform the electors of the municipality, and notice of such cancellation shall be posted at each polling place and in not less than one other public place.
