

No. 1—The Amsbary Ditch No. 1 Reservoir.

That said reservoir is used in connection with the Amsbary Ditch No. 1 in the irrigation of the land lying under said ditch, owned by Joseph M. Lamb, and the said reservoir is owned by Joseph M. Lamb; that the water herein decreed to Joseph Lamb through the said The Amsbary Ditch No. 1 shall be allowed to flow into said reservoir, as well as into said ditch, at any and all times when the owner thereof so desires. Provided, however, that the total amount of water appropriated by both the Amsbard Ditch No. 1 and said reservoir shall not exceed the quantity herein decreed to the Amsbary Ditch No. 1.

No. 2—The Ute Park Ditch and Reservoir.

No. 3—The Stonehenge Reservoir and Canal.

No. 4—The Woodruff Reservoir.

That the said The Ute Park Ditch and Reservoir, The Stonehenge Ditch and Canal and The Woodruff Reservoir have not yet appropriated water.

(44th)—And, more particularly, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed as follows, to-wit:

No. 1—The Hardscrabble Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 1, which is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 1; that Henry M. Burroughs is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 75 acres of land belonging to said Burroughs; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 1, for the use and benefit of said Burroughs and his heirs and assigns ninety-three hundred and
