

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Fifty-Fourth General Assembly enacted Senate Bill 172, concerning hazardous substance incidents, to become effective July 1, 1983;

WHEREAS, this law provides that the Board of Trustees of the Town of Stratton, by resolution or by Ordinance, shall designate the emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents occurring within the corporate limits of such town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF STRATTON THAT:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 29-22-102 (3) (a), C. R. S., The governing body of every town shall designate by ordinance or resolution an emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents occurring within the corporate limits of such town.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 29-22-103 (1) , C. R. S., The governing body of the Town of Stratton hereby designates the Mayor of the Town of Stratton to act on behalf of the town, which if in his or her judgement the town does not have the equipment, personnel, expertise necessary to handle a particular hazardous substance incident for which the Town of Stratton is responsible, he or she may request assistance from any public agency who is qualified.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 29-22-104, (1) C. R. S., as amended, a public entity, political subdivision of the State or unit of government is hereby given the right to claim reimbursement from the parties or persons responsible for a hazardous substance incident for the reasonable and documented costs resulting from action taken to remove, contain, or otherwise mitigate the effects of such incident.
