

RESOLUTION TO CANCEL ELECTION

A RESOLUTION CANCELING AN ELECTION UNDER THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION CODE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Stratton enacted Ordinance No. 69-A. An ordinance providing for the time for filing of notice of intent by a write-in candidate in municipal elections for the Town of Stratton, and providing for circumstances for cancellation of elections of the Town of Stratton, Colorado.


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, the governing body of the Town of Stratton, in the County of Kit Carson and State of Colorado declares that the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office and, at the close of business on the nineteenth day before the election, there were not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent. Therefore, the election to be held April 4, 2000 is hereby canceled. (C.R.S. 31-10-507)

NOW THEREFORE, The Board of Trustees declares the following candidates are elected and appointed to the following terms.

Trustees	Terry Baylie – four-year term

	Dana Sickman – four-year term
	Larry Shutte – two-year term
